

## Tools, Vegetation Management



### 1. Scope

This standard covers the requirements for vegetation management hand tools, which includes but is not limited to shovels, rakes, pruners, and axes.

This standard applies to the Seattle City Light (SCL) stock numbers cited in section 7.

### 2. Application

Hatchets, axes, and machetes are heavy duty striking tools with beveled cutting edges, used for chipping or hacking woody vegetation.

Shovels are used for digging, loosening, and transferring soil, sand, and gravel or debris.

Rakes are used for raking, leveling, and loosening loose garden material, such as leaves, peat moss and mulch.

Loppers are used for cutting and trimming small shrubs and branches.

Peaveys are used for gripping, maneuvering, and repositioning wooden utility poles.

Manure forks are used for picking up and transferring bulky materials such as manure, mulch, and other loose materials.

Picks are used for digging in hard-packed earth, particularly for long or deep ditches.

Tool handle wedges are used for securing wooden handles onto heads of hammers, axes, hatchets, and other tools.
